

Math

We are ringing in the New Year with a new unit, which focuses on place value. Given the spiraling nature of Everyday Mathematics, we will begin exploring place value deeper than in previous grades, in addition to revisiting old concepts. Students should still be practicing their 5-minute fast facts every night!

Science

We've studied the continents and the oceans, and now it's time to move onto bigger concepts, like space! We are going to begin studying our atmosphere!

Reading & Writing
